AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE FURNISHING OF ACCOMMODATIONS TO PERSONS DISPLACED BY THE TAKING OF LAND BY EMINENT DOMAIN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 79 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-  
2 ing after section 2 the following section:—

3 *Section 2A.* Before any land is taken by eminent domain by  
4 the commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof, suitable  
5 like accommodations shall be furnished the persons to be dis-  
6 placed by such takings.
