In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

Relative to Innholders and Common Victuallers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor and aldermen of any city, and
2 the selectmen of a town, except Boston and other cities
3 and towns in which licenses under chapter one hundred
4 of the Public Statutes are granted by boards of license
5 commissioners, may impose in licenses granted to inn-
6 holders and common victuallers in such city or town such
7 conditions as to said mayor and aldermen, selectmen or
8 board of license commissioners may seem just and rea-
9 sonable, and that when, in their opinion, the licensee has
10 violated any of such conditions, the license shall there-
11 upon become void.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
