## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATIVE TO THE CUSTODY OF MINOR CHILDREN SHALL NOT APPLY TO MINOR CHILDREN OF PARENTS WHO HAVE BEEN DIVORCED WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 201 of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 chapter 171 of the acts of 1961, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding at the end the following sentence:— This section shall  
4 not apply to minor children of parents divorced within the  
5 commonwealth.
