AN ACT GRANTING CREDIT FOR EXPERIENCE ON CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary in the marking
- 2 of any promotional examination, an applicant shall be given credit
- 3 in the amount of fifty percent of the passing grade, for experience
- 4 earned in any position which is related to or in the same service
- 5 group as the position for which said examination is being held.
