## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the Harbor and Land Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of  
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, for the eleven months  
5 ending on the thirtieth day of November, nine-  
6 teen hundred and six, to wit: —

7 For the salaries of the commissioners, seventy-  
8 nine hundred and seventy-five dollars. [Rev.  
9 Laws, ch. 96, sec. 1; Acts 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$8,700.)

10 For the compensation and expenses of the  
11 engineers and for clerical and other assistance  
12 authorized by the commissioners, a sum not ex-  
13 ceeding twenty-seven thousand dollars. [Rev.  
14 Laws, chs. 25 and 26; Acts 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$29,000.)

15 For travelling and other necessary expenses of  
16 the commissioners, a sum not exceeding six hun-  
17 dred eighty-seven dollars. [Rev. Laws, ch. 96;  
18 Acts 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$750.)

19 For incidental and contingent office expenses  
20 of the commissioners, to include printing and  
21 binding their annual report, a sum not exceeding  
22 two thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, ch. 96; Acts  
23 1902, ch. 438; 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$2,000.)

24 For printing town boundary atlases, a sum not  
25 exceeding three thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws,  
26 ch. 96; Acts 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$3,000.)

27 For surveys of harbors and for improving and  
28 preserving the same, and for repairing damages  
29 occasioned by storms along the coast line or river  
30 banks of the Commonwealth, a sum not exceed-  
31 ing forty-five hundred eighty-three dollars and  
32 thirty-three cents. [Rev. Laws, ch. 96, sec. 10;  
33 Acts 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$5,000.)

34 For the removal of wrecks and other obstruc-  
35 tions from the tide waters, a sum not exceeding  
36 nine hundred sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents.  
37 [Rev. Laws, ch. 97, sec. 22; Acts 1905, ch. 211.]

(Appropriation 1905, \$1,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
