AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO TAKE BY EMINENT DOMAIN CERTAIN LANDS IN THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT OF BOSTON FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING RECREATIONAL FACILITIES THEREON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to take by eminent domain the following parcels
- 3 of land and construct certain recreational facilities thereon:—
- 4 (a) Certain lands extending from Tenean beach to the junc-
- 5 tion of Tenean and Lawley streets in the Dorchester district of
- 6 the city of Boston and to construct a marina thereon.
- 7 (b) Certain lands in said Dorchester district, adjacent to
- 8 Tenean beach and the Southeast expressway, and to extend
- 9 thereon the recreational facilities of said Tenean beach. For
- 10 said purposes, the metropolitan district commission may expend
- 11 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
