AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 19C the following section:—
3 Section 19D. Manufacturers of alcoholic beverages, whether
4 organized under the laws of this Commonwealth or organized
5 under the laws of any other state of the United States and admitted
6 to do business in this Commonwealth, who are required to file a
7 labelling application with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and
8 Firearms to remain in compliance with federal laws, shall file
9 same with the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission with a
10 filing fee of one hundred dollars accompanying said application.
