AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEES FOR EXAMINATIONS BY THE  
COMMISSIONER OF BANKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 167 of the General Laws, as most re-
- 2 cently amended by chapter 684 of the acts of 1975, is hereby
- 3 further amended by striking the second sentence of the sec-
- 4 ond paragraph thereof and inserting instead the following
- 5 sentence: —
- 6 “The charge for such examination or audit shall be sixty
- 7 dollars per day for each man participating therein, except,
- 8 that the assessment for an examiner in charge of an exami-
- 9 nation or audit shall be ninety dollars per day.”
