
To accompany the petition of H. C. Wadleigh that the sale within the Commonwealth of farm produce not produced therein be regulated. Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act regulating the Sale within the Commonwealth of Farm Produce not Produced Therein.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety-four of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section one hundred
3 and seventeen F, as appearing in the Tercentenary
4 edition, the following new section:—

5 *Section 117G.* No farm produce not produced
6 within the commonwealth shall be sold at whole-
7 sale therein unless in the original package in which
8 the same was brought into the commonwealth,
9 which shall be so marked and labelled as to ap-
10 prise all purchasers that the same was grown or
11 produced without the commonwealth. The com-
12 missioner shall make rules and regulations provid-
13 ing for the enforcement of this section. Violation
14 of this section shall be punished by a fine of not
15 more than dollars or by imprisonment for
16 not more than , or by both.
