### AN ACT INCREASING THE PENSIONS OF ALL RETIRED CITY EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of any law to the con-  
2 trary notwithstanding, the pensions of all retired city  
3 employees shall be computed on the basis of the present  
4 salaries and wages of the respective positions.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
