**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW PROVIDING FOR PRE-PRIMARY CONVENTIONS OF POLITICAL PARTIES AND REVIVING AND CONTINUING IN FORCE CERTAIN OTHER LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All provisions of sections fifty-four, fifty-four  
2 C, fifty-four D of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws, as  
3 most recently amended by chapter two hundred and thirty of  
4 the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, providing for state  
5 conventions of political parties for the endorsement for nomi-  
6 nation of candidates for offices to be filled by all the voters of  
7 the commonwealth, and all other laws relative to such conven-  
8 tions, are hereby repealed. All provisions of law which have  
9 been stricken or amended by said sections fifty-four, fifty-four  
10 C, fifty-four D of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws, as  
11 most recently amended by chapter two hundred and thirty of  
12 the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, or by any other  
13 law relative to such conventions are hereby revived as they  
14 existed immediately prior to such striking or amendment, sub-  
15 ject, however, to all subsequent amendments not relating to  
16 such conventions, all of which subsequent amendments are  
17 hereby continued in force.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
