

SENATE No. 245

To accompany the petition of Conde Brodbine and Thomas F. Carroll that the Department of Public Works be authorized to lay out and construct certain highways in the cities of Revere and Boston. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to the Laying Out and Construction of Certain Highways in the Cities of Revere and Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works
2 hereinafter called the department is hereby
3 authorized to lay out, construct and improve
4 ways for motor vehicles and other traffic in the
5 cities of Revere and Boston.

6 (a) Beginning at a point at the corner of North
7 Shore road and Cove street in the said city of
8 Revere and thence at a southwesterly direction
9 on Curtis road in the city of Revere to Bennington
10 street near the Narrow Gauge bridge on said
11 Bennington street in the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. The department may on behalf
2 of the commonwealth take by eminent domain
3 under chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws,
4 or acquire by purchase or otherwise, such public,
5 private lands or rights therein as it may deem
6 necessary in the carrying out of the provisions of
7 this act.

1 SECTION 3. The costs of laying out, con-
2 structing and improving said proposed new way,
3 including any damages for any taking of land or
4 property, shall be deemed to be the cost of the
5 work and shall be apportioned as follows: two
6 thirds to be paid out of the Highway Fund and
7 one third by the city of Revere and Boston in
8 proportion to the amount of roadway in each of
9 said cities.

1 SECTION 4. When the work authorized shall
2 have been completed, it shall be kept in good
3 repair by the public works department of the
4 commonwealth.
