
Resolve accompanying the petition of George Ward Cook for legislation to provide for the representation of the Commonwealth at the exposition to be held at Seattle in the State of Washington. Federal Relations. January 8.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

RESOLVE

Relative to the Exposition to be held at Seattle in the State of Washington.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of providing at the
2 Seattle exposition, to be held in the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and nine in the state of Washington, a suitable
4 representation of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
5 either in co-operation with other New England states,
6 or alone, a board of exposition managers for Massachu-
7 setts consisting of five members shall be appointed by
8 the governor with the advice and consent of the council.
9 One of said managers may be appointed as executive
10 manager with a salary to be named by the governor, the
11 others to serve without compensation.
12 They shall have charge of the interests of the Com-
13 monwealth in preparation of exhibits of its history,
14 manufacturing and resources generally.
15 To provide for this resolve there shall be placed at
16 the disposal of the governor and council a sum not ex-
17 ceeding twelve thousand dollars, to be expended by
18 them for the best interests of the Commonwealth.
