AN ACT CHANGING THE JOB GROUP CLASSIFICATIONS OF CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, the director of the division of personnel and standard-
3 ization is hereby authorized and directed to advance the posi-
4 tions of storekeeper, principal storekeeper, stores examiner and
5 head storekeeper and examiner in the department of public
6 works two job groups above the job groups to which the said
7 positions are assigned on the effective date of this act in accord-
8 ance with the schedule appearing in subdivision (1) of section
9 forty-six of chapter thirty of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July first, nine-
2 teen hundred and sixty-two.

The Constitution of the State

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of members chosen by the electors of the several counties.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen by the electors of the several counties.

Section 4. The members of the Senate shall hold their offices for four years.

Section 5. The members of the House of Representatives shall hold their offices for two years.

Section 6. The electors of the several counties shall choose the members of the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 7. The electors of the several counties shall choose the members of the Senate and House of Representatives.
