## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT THE POSITION OF NEGOTIATOR IN THE RIGHT OF WAY DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 606 of the acts of 1960 is hereby amended by adding  
2 the following paragraph at the end thereof: —

3 The provisions of this act shall include and apply to all tempo-  
4 rary employees of the right of way division of the department  
5 of public works who were qualified as negotiators by civil service  
6 examination of December tenth, nineteen hundred and sixty,  
7 and certified by the civil service commission on June thirteenth,  
8 nineteen hundred and sixty-one. Salaries of said negotiators  
9 shall be charged to and made payable from the general funds of  
10 the commonwealth; and the budget commissioner shall include  
11 in his budget such sum or sums of money as may be necessary  
12 for this purpose. The commission on administration and  
13 finance shall direct the transfer from the highway fund of such  
14 sum or sums of money so expended for salaries to the general  
15 funds of the commonwealth.
