1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Banks and Banking is hereby
2 authorized to make an investigation and study of the laws of the
3 commonwealth regulating the use of electronic funds transfers by
4 means of automatic teller machines. The committee shall, in the
5 course of its investigation and study consider the subject matter of
6 current Senate document numbered 1863, and such related matters
7 as the committee may deem necessary.

8 Said committee may report, from time to time, to the General
9 Court the results of its investigation and study and its recommenda-
10 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
11 such recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk
12 of the Senate or the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or
13 before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and
14 ninety-five.
