AN ACT INCREASING THE MAXIMUM AGGREGATE NUMBER OF RACING DAYS FOR HARNESS HORSE RACING MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (j) of subsection (5) of section 3 of chapter 128A of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 4 of chapter 575 of
3 the acts of 1946, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2,
4 the word "ninety" and inserting in place thereof the following
5 words:—one hundred and twenty.
