AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 112, Section 87CC of the General Laws as appearing
- 2 in the 1990 Official Edition is hereby amended by the deletion of
- 3 the second paragraph, comprising lines twenty-two through
- 4 thirty, in its entirety.
- 5 Said Chapter 112, Section 87CC is further amended by the
- 6 deletion of the fifth paragraph, comprising lines fifty-two through
- 7 fifty-seven, in its entirety.
