## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

### AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 85K. Any employee of a city or town eligible for  
2 retirement who is classified in Group 4 may request in an  
3 application for retirement that he be credited with an additional  
4 retirement benefit in accordance with the provisions of this  
5 section, provided, however, that each such employee shall request  
6 and receive five years of creditable service or five years of age or  
7 a combination thereof the sum of which shall not be greater than  
8 five years for the purpose of determining his superannuation  
9 retirement allowance pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (a)  
10 of subdivision (2) of section five of chapter thirty-two of the  
11 General Laws.

12 Notwithstanding such credit, the total amount of the retirement  
13 allowance, as determined in accordance with the provisions of  
14 section five of any such employee who retires and receives the  
15 retirement benefit provided by this section shall not exceed four-  
16 fifths of the average annual rate of his compensation as  
17 determined in accordance with said section.
