**AN ACT INCREASING THE MAXIMUM SALARY WHICH MAY BE PAID
TO THE CITY MANAGER IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of section
2 eighty-nine of chapter forty-three of the General Laws to
3 the contrary, the city manager in the city of Haverhill shall
4 receive such compensation as the city council of said city
5 shall fix by ordinance, but not exceeding fifteen thousand dol-
6 lars annually.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to
2 the registered voters of the city of Haverhill at its regular
3 city election in the current year in the form of the following
4 question, which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be
5 used at said election: — "Shall an act passed by the General
6 Court in the current year, entitled 'An Act increasing the
7 maximum salary which may be paid to the city manager in
8 the city of Haverhill', be accepted?" If a majority of the votes
9 in answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act shall
10 thereupon take effect, but not otherwise.
