AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL
TECHNICIANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Group 4 of Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of Chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, is hereby
3 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:— and uniformed employees of a
4 municipal or public emergency medical service who are certified at any level as an Emergency
5 Medical Technician by the Department of Public Health.
