1 *Ordered*, That a special committee consisting of five members
2 of the house of representatives to be designated by the speaker
3 thereof, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
4 investigation and study of the administration of the motor
5 vehicle excise tax program, the reason for the many errors in the
6 nineteen hundred and seventy-one excise tax bills and such other
7 matters relative thereto which the committee deems relevant and
8 proper.

9 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
10 house or elsewhere, and may expend for clerical and other
11 necessary expenses, such sums as may be appropriated therefor,
12 and shall report to the general court the results of its investiga-
13 tion and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with
14 drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations into
15 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
16 representatives on or before the third Wednesday in December in
17 the current year.
