

HOUSE No. 657

By Mr. Burke of Natick, petition of Walter T. Burke that the Department of Public Works be directed to acquire land in Natick for the purpose of providing an ingress at the intersection of Route 9 and Center Street. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN LAND IN NATICK LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 9 AND CENTER STREET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, on behalf of
2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to take by eminent
3 domain, under the provisions of chapter seventy-nine of the
4 General Laws, or acquire by purchase, transfer or otherwise,
5 sufficient land located at the northeasterly corner of the inter-
6 section of route 9 and Center street in the town of Natick, and
7 to construct an ingress on route 9 at said location. Any person
8 whose property has been so taken or injured by the department
9 of public works under authority of this act, may recover com-
10 pensation therefor from the commonwealth under said chapter
11 seventy-nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 2. No State shall have Representatives or Delegates in Congress more than one for every thirty Thousand Persons, but each State shall have at least one Representative; and until such Time as they shall amount to the Number aforesaid, the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
