RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Plymouth.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
2 priated for the expenses of the county of Plymouth for
3 the year nineteen hundred and six : —
4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding four
5 thousand five hundred dollars.
6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
7 twenty-two thousand three hundred dollars and fifty-six
8 cents.
9 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
10 law, a sum not exceeding eleven thousand five hundred
11 dollars.
12 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not
13 exceeding five thousand six hundred dollars.
14 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
15 a sum not exceeding twenty-one thousand dollars.
16 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
17 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
18 not exceeding eighteen thousand dollars.
19 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not
20 exceeding eighteen thousand dollars.

21 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
22 courts, a sum not exceeding nine thousand dollars.

23 For transportation expenses of county and associate
24 commissioners, a sum not exceeding four hundred dol-
25 lars.

26 For medical examiners, inquests and commitments of
27 the insane, a sum not exceeding three thousand five hun-
28 dred dollars.

29 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
30 ing two thousand dollars.

31 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
32 ings, a sum not exceeding thirteen thousand five hundred
33 dollars.

34 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
35 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
36 same, a sum not exceeding four thousand five hundred
37 dollars.

38 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
39 land damages, a sum not exceeding seven thousand dol-
40 lars.

41 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding two thousand
42 three hundred dollars.

43 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
44 rent year, a sum not exceeding four thousand five hun-
45 dred sixteen dollars and fifty-three cents.

46 And the county commissioners of said county are
47 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said
48 county for the current year, in the manner provided by
49 law, the sum of one hundred and twenty-five thousand
50 dollars, to be expended, together with the cash balance
51 on hand and the receipts from other sources, for the
52 above purposes.
