## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-four.

### AN ACT

For the Prevention of the False Impersonation of Voters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Whenever the chairman and secretary of the committee  
2 of any political party in any city or town represented on  
3 the official ballot shall so request, permission shall be  
4 given by the officers having charge of a voting place to a  
5 representative of such party to stand next to the box of  
6 the voting place, and for the purpose of identification  
7 there photograph persons within the bar as they shall  
8 pass up to vote.
