AN ACT MAKING THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY AND THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY COTERMINOUS WITH THAT OF THE GOVERNOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 2 of chapter  
2 465 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 fourth, fifth and sixth sentences and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following sentence:— Upon the expiration of the term of  
5 any member his successor shall be appointed by the governor  
6 and shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of section 3 of chapter  
2 354 of the acts of 1952 is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 fifth sentence:— Upon the expiration of the term of each  
4 member his successor shall be appointed by the governor and  
5 shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.

1 SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall affect the terms of office  
2 of persons holding the offices of member of the Massachusetts  
3 Port Authority or the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority, im-  
4 mediately prior to the effective date of this act, who shall con-  
5 tinue in office until the expiration of the term for which they  
6 were appointed.
