In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY THROUGH THE PROPER INSTALLATION OF UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS AND APPURTENANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Add a new section to Chapter 148 of the General Laws: —
- 2 The Board may make rules and regulations as it deems
- 3 necessary and appropriate for the licensing of business entities
- 4 and/or for the issuance of certificates of competency to indi-
- 5 viduals following the completion of an examination adminis-
- 6 tered by the Department of Public Safety, to persons who are
- 7 engaged or who will become engaged in the business of installing,
- 8 servicing, maintaining, altering, testing, repairing, monitoring or
- 9 removing underground storage tanks and related underground
- 10 appurtenances.
