**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETENTION OF CERTAIN REGULATIONS
RELATIVE TO DAY CARE CENTERS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The rules and regulations of the department of public health in
2 effect as of January first, nineteen hundred and seventy relative
3 to the teacher-pupil ratio and qualifications of directors in day
4 care centers shall remain in effect without amendment for a
5 period of one year after the effective date of this act.
