

By Mr. Corbett of Somerville, petition of William P. Corbett that street railway companies be required to equip their cars with automatic window wipers or cleaners. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act requiring Street Railway Cars to be equipped with Automatic Window Wipers or Cleaners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section ninety-eight of chapter one hundred and
2 sixty-one of the General Laws, as amended by chap-
3 ter four hundred and thirty of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and twenty-two, is hereby further amended
5 by adding at the end thereof the following: — Every
6 such car when in use shall also have attached to the
7 window in front of the operator of such car an auto-
8 matic window wiper or cleaner, — so as to read as
9 follows: — *Section 98.* A company shall equip its
10 cars, when in use, with such headlights, fenders,
11 wheel guards, brakes, and other safety devices, and
12 shall provide such protection, human or otherwise,
13 at its station platforms, as may be required from
14 time to time by the department. Every such car
15 when in use shall also have attached to the window
16 in front of the operator of such car an automatic
17 window wiper or cleaner.
