AN ACT TO AMEND THE EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO INCLUDE THE CHILDREN OF ONE HUNDRED PER CENT WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABLED VETERANS BE INCLUDED IN THE EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7B of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 492 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting in the first sentence thereof after the words
4 "as a result of such service", the following words: -- or who has
5 been rated one hundred per cent disabled from wartime service-
6 connected causes.
