AN ACT

Relative to Temporary Loans by Fire Districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Fire districts may, by ordinary
2 vote, incur debts for temporary loans in antici-
3 pation of the taxes of the municipal year in which
4 such debts are incurred, and in anticipation of
5 receipts from water rates due in such year, and
6 expressly made payable from such taxes and water
7 rates by vote of the fire district.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
