AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE RACIAL IMBALANCE LAW SHALL NOT APPLY TO PUPILS ATTENDING THE FIRST SIX GRADES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 38D of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in section 1 of chapter 641 of the acts of 1965, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:—
- 4 The provisions of this section shall not apply to pupils attend-
- 5 ing the first six grades in public schools.
