AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN THE AREA NOW KNOWN AS THE PINWOOD GOLF COURSE IN THE SAXONVILLE DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM TO BE OPERATED AS A PUBLIC GOLF COURSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to acquire by eminent domain,  
3 under chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws, or by  
4 purchase or otherwise, and may expend such sums as  
5 may hereafter be appropriated therefor, the Pinewood  
6 golf course, so called, in the Saxonville district of the  
7 town of Framingham, consisting of the land and build-  
8 ings, and said department shall maintain and operate  
9 said area as an eighteen-hole public golf course.

1 SECTION 2. Said department may establish rules and  
2 regulations and make reasonable charges for the use of  
3 said golf course, lockers and service buildings, and all  
4 sums of money received by said department from said  
5 charges shall be accounted for and paid to the state  
6 treasurer, who shall receive and hold the same as a  
7 special fund to be used as a credit toward the cost of the  
8 maintenance and operation of the golf course acquired  
9 under the provisions of this act.
