Accompanying the petition of Merle Dixon Graves relative to clerical assistance for police, district and municipal courts. Public Service. January 12.

AN ACT

Relative to Clerical Assistance for Police, District and Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section seventy-one of chapter two hundred and eight-
2 een of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
3 out said section and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing:— *Section 71.* Upon the certificate of the justice and
5 the clerk of any district court, except the municipal court
6 of the city of Boston, that extra clerical assistance was
7 actually performed and was necessary, stating the names
8 of the persons by whom it was performed and the time
9 occupied, the clerk shall be allowed such amounts as the
10 county commissioners, in a writing signed by them, by
11 vote, may approve. Said amounts shall be paid by the
12 county monthly to the persons employed.
