## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO SELL CERTAIN LAND OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO THE ITALIAN CATHOLIC CEMETERY ASSOCIATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner of mental health in the name and on behalf  
2 of the commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to sell  
3 to the Italian Catholic Cemetery Association, a corporation  
4 having an usual place of business in the city of Boston, a certain  
5 parcel of land located in the West Roxbury district of said city  
6 and bounded and described as follows:—Northwesterly by  
7 Canterbury street; northeasterly by land, under the jurisdic-  
8 tion of the division of youth service, of the commonwealth of  
9 Massachusetts; southeasterly by American Legion Highway;  
10 and southwesterly by Walk Hill street; containing approxi-  
11 mately twelve and one half acres, including a portion of Stony  
12 brook and a forty foot easement for sewer purposes.

13 The sale price of said parcel of land shall be its fair value to  
14 be determined by an independent appraiser appointed by the  
15 commissioner of administration.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ESTABLISH A BOARD OF PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO THE SAME EXTENT AS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Senate Chamber, and by the authority of the State, on 15th day of January, 1905.

- 1 The members of said board shall be appointed by the Governor and Council.
- 2 of the Commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to well
- 3 to the Public Health Commission, a corporation
- 4 having an equal share of business in the city of Boston, a certain
- 5 parcel of land located in the West Boston district of said city
- 6 and bounded and described as follows:—Beginning at the
- 7 corner of the street, northwesterly by said street to the junction
- 8 line of the district of South Boston of the Commonwealth of
- 9 Massachusetts, and westerly by said street to the corner of
- 10 and northwesterly by said street to the corner of
- 11 street, and easterly and southerly by said street to the corner of
- 12 street and a forty foot corner lot in said district.
- 13 The title to said parcel of land shall be the title to
- 14 be determined by an arbitrator appointed by the
- 15 Commissioner of Administration.
