### AN ACT

To regulate the Fares of Street Railway Companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The rates of fare charged by street rail-  
2 way companies for the transportation of passengers shall  
3 not exceed five cents within the limits of any town; nor  
4 shall the rates of fare exceed five cents from a point in  
5 one town to a point in any other town when the distance  
6 which the passenger rides in travelling between said  
7 points does not exceed six miles.

1 SECTION 2. Any street railway company violating  
2 the provisions of this act shall forfeit the sum of twenty-  
3 five dollars for each offence.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
