### R E S O L V E S

Concerning the Indebtedness and Taxation of Cities and Towns.

*Resolved,* That the treasurers of the several cities and towns shall, on or before the tenth day December next, return to the secretary of the Commonwealth the amount of indebtedness of their respective cities and towns, what amount thereof was incurred for expenses incident to the present war, and what amount of the same is to be reimbursed by the Commonwealth, under the provisions of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the acts of the current year, and what sum is due to the Commonwealth by the provisions of the same act.

*Resolved,* That the secretary of the Commonwealth shall, on or before the twenty-fifth day of November instant, transmit to the several cities and towns, blank forms directed to the treasurers thereof, to enable them to make the returns herein prescribed.

*Resolved*, That the secretary shall make a digest of the returns of the treasurers made to him in conformity with the foregoing resolves, and the provisions of the one hundred and sixty-seventh chapter of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, in convenient form, and cause the same to be printed for the use of the next legislature.

*Resolved*, If any treasurer wilfully refuses or neglects to perform any duty imposed on him in the foregoing resolves he shall forfeit a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars.
