AN ACT

To ratify and confirm Certain Proceedings of the
Juniper Point Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The proceedings of any meetings of the Juni-
2 per Point Association, a corporation duly or-
3 ganized under the laws of the Commonwealth of
4 Massachusetts, shall not be invalid because its
5 records do not show that certain clerks of said as-
6 sociation were duly sworn or that certain meetings
7 were duly notified, or because said clerks were not
8 sworn according to law or said meetings duly noti-
9 fied or because of any omission to hold any annual
10 meeting; and all acts and proceedings of said asso-
11 ciation since its incorporation are hereby ratified
12 and confirmed to the same extent as such acts and
13 proceedings would have been valid if said clerks
14 had been duly sworn and all meetings had been duly
15 notified and held.
