AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN FUNDS
AND PROPERTY OF COMPANIES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS
STATE GUARD UPON THEIR DISBANDMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Upon the disbandment of any company of the
2 Massachusetts state guard, all funds of such company,
3 other than those allotted to it by the commonwealth,
4 and all property purchased by such company with
5 funds other than those allotted as aforesaid, may be
6 disposed of by such company in such manner as it
7 may determine.
