AN ACT DESIGNATING HUNTS FALLS BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF
LOWELL AS THE EDITH NOURSE ROGERS DISABLED AMERICAN
VETERANS BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Hunts Falls bridge, in the city of Lowell, shall be
2 known and designated as the Edith Nourse Rogers Dis-
3 abled American Veterans bridge. The department of
4 public works is hereby authorized and directed to erect
5 on said bridge a suitable tablet or marker bearing such
6 designation, and may expend therefor such sum as may
7 hereafter be appropriated.
