

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of chapter six hundred and sixty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, as amended by section one of this act, the incumbents of the offices of chief of police and deputy chief of police of the police department of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall continue to be employed without loss of civil service, retirement, vacation or any other rights.

Chap. 830. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WOBURN TO PAY CERTAIN SCHOOL CUSTODIANS A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR OVERTIME WORK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The city of Woburn is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay to certain custodians in the school department of said city, the sum of twenty-four thousand eight hundred eighty-seven dollars and twenty-five cents for overtime work performed between the period of February ten, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight to and through April four, nineteen hundred and seventy.

Chap. 831. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE OVERPASS ON MT. PLEASANT STREET OVER ROUTE 140 IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AS THE WILLIAM C. MEDEIROS MEMORIAL OVERPASS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The overpass being constructed on Mt. Pleasant street over state highway route 140 in the city of New Bedford shall, upon completion, be known and designated as the William C. Medeiros Memorial overpass in memory of Lance Corporal William C. Medeiros who was killed in action while a member of the United States Marine Corps in the Vietnam campaign. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works.

Chap. 832. AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON SAVINGS DEPOSITS IN TRUST COMPANIES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 61 of chapter 172 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 105 of the acts of 1962, is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

Any such corporation may pay interest on regular savings accounts at such rate as its board of directors may determine and may pay variable rates of interest on other types of savings accounts; provided, however, that the rates so paid shall be consistent with the maximum rates from time to time established by the appropriate federal supervisory agencies. In the event that such federal supervisory agencies cease to establish such maximum rates, then any such corporation may

pay interest on regular savings accounts at such rate as its board of directors may determine, and may, with the approval of the commissioner, pay variable rates of interest on other types of savings accounts; provided, however, that no such rate shall exceed seven per cent per annum.

Chap. 833. AN ACT IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO SUPPLEMENT CERTAIN ITEMS CONTAINED THEREIN, AND FOR CERTAIN NEW ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act and for certain new activities and projects, the sums set forth in section two for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified therein are hereby appropriated from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in the item, subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter four hundred and eighty of the acts of the current year, for the fiscal year ending June the thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, or for such period as may be specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition to any amounts at present available for the purposes.
