AN ACT

To equalize the Salaries of the Assistant District Attorneys for the Suffolk District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the second assistant
2 district attorney for the Suffolk district shall be
3 the same as that received by the first assistant
4 district attorney for said district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from the
2 first day of January eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 eight.
