AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 25 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 105 of chapter 872 of the  
3 acts of 1977, is hereby amended by striking out the second  
4 sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 2 of said chapter 25 is hereby fur-  
2 ther amended by inserting after the first paragraph the follow-  
3 ing paragraph:

4 On January 1, 1984, the governor with the advice and con-  
5 sent of the senate shall appoint a chairman to serve for a  
6 term of six years, a commissioner to serve for a term of four  
7 years and a commissioner to serve for a term of two years.  
8 Upon the expiration of the term of a member, the governor  
9 with the advice and consent of the senate shall appoint his  
10 successor for a term of six years.
