AN ACT

Relative to the Granting of Sixth-class Liquor  
Licenses to Druggists.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Section eleven of chapter three hundred and  
2 ninety-seven of the acts of the year eighteen  
3 hundred and ninety-six is hereby amended by  
4 striking out the whole of said section, and insert-  
5 ing in place thereof the following:—  
6 *Section 11.* The possession of a certificate of  
7 registration in pharmacy shall be accepted as evi-  
8 dence of fitness of an applicant for a sixth-class  
9 liquor license, and the licensing board or commis-  
10 sion of a city or town shall deem that the public  
11 good will be promoted by granting such applica-  
12 tion: *provided, however,* said applicant shall have  
13 conducted their business in accordance with the  
14 provision of law.
