## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE COMPUTATION OF THE CREDIT ALLOWABLE FOR TAXES PAID TO OTHER STATES, TERRITORIES, DEPENDENCIES OF THE UNITED STATES, OR THE DOMINION OF CANADA OR ANY OF ITS PROVINCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6A of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 677 of the acts of 1957, shall  
3 be amended by inserting after the word "paid" where it first  
4 appears in the first sentence, the words: — or payable for the  
5 taxable year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be effective for all taxable years  
2 ending on and after December thirty-first, nineteen hundred  
3 and fifty-five.
