SENATE No. 1148

By Mr. W. Paul White, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1148) of Kathleen A. Kelley and W. Paul White for legislation to provide for the continuation of the terms and conditions of a collective bargaining agreement during the period of its renegotiation. Public Service.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT DURING THE PERIOD OF ITS RENEGOTIATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 G.L. c.150E, Section 6 is hereby amended by adding the
2 following sentence: "During the period of the renegotiation of a
3 successor collective bargaining agreement, the terms and
4 conditions of the expired collective bargaining agreement shall
5 remain in full force and effect until a successor agreement has
6 been agreed to by and between the said exclusive representatives
7 and the employer thereto."
