

time of application provide the director such reasonable information as he may require concerning the amount and type of forest products cut by him during the previous year. The fee for the issuance of such licenses, which shall expire on June the thirtieth of each year, shall be five dollars for residents and ten dollars for nonresidents.

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars for each violation. The superior court shall have jurisdiction in equity to enforce the provisions of sections forty-two to forty-six, inclusive, and remedy any violations thereof.

Chap. 757. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION OF AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE ATLANTIC STATES MARINE FISHERIES COMMISSION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 489 of the acts of 1941 is hereby amended by striking out section 4, as amended by chapter 798 of the acts of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 4. Each member of the commission designated or appointed by the governor who, while such member, neither holds a salaried state office nor is a member of the general court shall, while a member of the commission, be paid by the commonwealth as compensation for his services the sum of thirty dollars per day for each day's service performed in connection with his duties as such member and the necessary traveling and other expenses actually incurred by him in the performance of said duties. Such compensation and expenses shall not exceed eight hundred dollars in any year. Such compensation shall be paid by the state treasurer to each member, not more often than every two weeks, out of the Marine Fisheries Fund, upon bills approved by the department of natural resources.

Chap. 758. AN ACT EXEMPTING LABOR RELATIONS EXAMINERS AND CONFIDENTIAL SECRETARIES FROM THE LAW RELATIVE TO WORKING HOURS AND OVERTIME PAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 30A of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word "ninety", in line 16, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 430 of the acts of 1960, the words:—, labor relations examiners, — and by inserting after the word "assistants", in line 18, the words:—, confidential secretaries.

SECTION 2. Section 30B of said chapter 149 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "adjuster", in line 9, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 762 of the acts of 1960, the words:—, labor relations examiners, — and by inserting after the word "assistants", in lines 10 and 11, the words:—, confidential secretaries.
