AN ACT AVOIDING DUPLICATE MEDICAID PAYMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section twenty-nine of chapter 283
3 of the Acts of 1976, is hereby amended by adding the follow-
4 ing sentence: —

5 No physician shall submit a bill for goods or services ren-
6 dered if said physician is a salaried employee of a hospital and
7 the hospital has already submitted a bill for such goods or
8 services.
