AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ALTERNATE DELEGATES FROM CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE OLD COLONY PLANNING DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 332 of the acts of 1967 is hereby amended
2 by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:—
3 There shall be an alternate delegate from each city and town
4 of the Old Colony Planning District established by section three
5 who shall be appointed for a term of three years by the mayor,
6 or in the case of a town, by concurrent vote of the board of
7 selectmen and planning board. The alternate delegate shall act
8 as the official representative of the city or town which he repre-
9 sents in the absence of the appointed representative and shall
10 have the right to vote on behalf of the city or town in the de-
11 liberation of the council when he is acting as said official rep-
12 resentative of the city or town.
