AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE GRANTING OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN BOWLING ALLEYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out section 16D, added by section 1 of chapter 478 of the acts of
- 3 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 4 *Section 16D.* No license for the sale of alcoholic beverages shall
- 5 be granted for that portion of any building or premises licensed for
- 6 the purpose of bowling or any game similar thereto regardless of its
- 7 designation; provided, however, an entrance or exit may open
- 8 from a licensed premises into said portion of a building duly
- 9 licensed for bowling, so long as no alcoholic beverages are allowed
- 10 on the premises so licensed.
